



2025 RUDOLF AMMANN PRIZE

Call for Applications

The European Pancreatic Club is pleased to announce an annual award, which is intended to support and promote research on the exocrine pancreas in maintaining good health and understanding mechanisms that can lead to diseases of the exocrine pancreas.

The overarching goal of this award is to improve the health status and quality of life for our patients in the future. As such, any funded research can be clinical or pre-clinical as long as there is a perspective for translation into the clinic.

To further support the emerging field of Pancreatology, priority has been given to young investigators.

The value of this award is **5,000 EURO**, and it is made possible by a generous educational grant donated by Nordmark Pharma GmbH.

Eligibility

- Under 45 years of age on January 1st, 2025
- Membership in the European Pancreatic Club at time of application
- Registration to the EPC Annual Meeting in Düsseldorf at time of application
- Focus of research is exocrine pancreatic function (clinical or translational). NB: not cancer
- Being first (or co-first) author of a paper printed in 2023 or 2024 on the topic of interest (not “epub ahead of print”)
- Preference will be given to papers that derive from abstract presented, even in preliminary form, during a prior EPC meeting (not compulsory)
- Impact factor of the Journal will not be the key factor for the prize to be given

Documents and submission deadline

Please submit the following documents in full for your application for the Rudolf Ammann Prize:

- pdf file of the publication published in a peer-reviewed journal
- A summary of no more than half an A4 page that outlines the significance of the research results against the background of the current state of knowledge
- A signed short CV of the applicant (an A4 page)
- Notification at which EPC meeting an according abstract has been presented in the cover letter (if applicable)
- **The documents must be submitted by May 1st, 2025**

Jury

An independent EPC Awards Committee will assess applications.

The winner will be notified by June 2nd 2025.
